Innovative Services: Copies Direct

- To assist in ordering material directly from the National Library of Australia
- A single entry point for users requesting a copy of any item in the Library's collections
- Copies from books, journals, newspapers, pictures, manuscripts, oral history transcripts, maps, tapes and recordings etc. can be availed of by paying certain charges
- Requested copies can be provided under the fair use provisions of the Copyright Act
