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Intrapreneurship

An intrapreneur is someone who:

- a. The person who does entrepreneurial work within an organization is an intrapreneur, and the process by which he/she affects change, intrapreneurship.
- b. Thus, intrapreneurs are called as employed entrepreneurs who work within the constraints and support of complex organizations. Their work takes place within the context of organizational responsibilities and relationship. They exist at all levels in organizations.



Intrapreneurship

- c. Works within a company to develop an idea into a workable product.
- d. Intrapreneurs are given a high level of autonomy for their projects by the companies they work for and they are often said to be acting essentially like entrepreneurs without the risks associated with being an entrepreneur.
- e. Intrapreneurs are also strongly linked as imagination includes exploring possible barriers and problems facing the project and figuring out various solutions.



PARADIGM SHIFT IN MANAGERIAL CHARACTERISTICS

Traditional Librarian	Intrapreneurial Librarian
Considers him/herself as the Librarian. Primary motive is power.	Considers him/herself as a team leader, mentor, and Role Model. Primary motive is autonomy.
Follows a defined chain of command.	Deals with anyone necessary to make a decision or do the job.
Manages information.	Shares information.
Has the confidence to make decisions alone.	Accepts responsibility but involves others in the decision.



PARADIGM SHIFT IN MANAGERIAL CHARACTERISTICS

Traditional Librarian	Intrapreneurial Librarian
Concentrates on what he or she is best at, such as finance or marketing.	Tries to master a number of management disciplines, forever learning.
Demands hard work; expects long hours as evidence of commitment.	Demands result.
Imposes decisions.	Creates options.
Is rigid.	Is flexible. Understands situations.
Usually delegates & supervises.	No hesitation in doing any work, may delegate also.
Keeps attention on events inside the organization.	Keeps attention on events both inside and outside.



PARADIGM SHIFT IN MANAGERIAL CHARACTERISTICS

Traditional Librarian	Intrapreneurial Librarian
Is very careful in taking risk.	Is moderate risk taker, may take little personal risk.
Status symbol more important.	Freedom symbols more important.
Tendency to agree with boss.	Capable at getting others to agree, has more patience.
